
Jim Langley gave a great program Henry Ford the Realtor. It was enjoyed by all. Thank you, Jim.

March program will be presented by Joe Spooner.


Having no further business meeting was adjourned.

Bobby started our meeting with Joe, Billy, and Jim (partially shown).




Al is using his coffee cup as a hand warmer. Joe carter just looks cold.


This "One of a Kind" Ford now resides in Auburn, Alabama.

Women's household aprons were made from handkerchief weight organdie and full gum rubber, and everything in between.




Aprons could be purchased ready to wear, or stamped with a pattern to be embroidered and finished by the buyer. Such as this example,
