



Our MATTS team met on the first Friday of August to learn about the mechanics of the Model 'A' shifting tower and to help a member of our group who was having trouble shifting his Model 'A'.

See the vent hole in the casting. Joe Spooner points out when reassembling the tower this vent hole must be open to relieve any pressure that could cause an oil leak.


