





Then we backtracked to Rt 80 going further east to Rt 355 near Juniper, Ga.

Passed Lake Juniper with a neat history as a family party place in olden days, passed the Buck air strip that is being made into a solar panel field. Welcome to the new century. Lots of big farms on Rt 355, then turned southeast on Rt 352 to see the

General Store along there.



WE couldn't get into the store as we were 20 minutes early but Buena Vista was waiting for us, so we headed on to town. Nice scenery on these county roads. The street by the Court House was blocked off for our parking. The building was neat and had 3 antique cars inside too. A 56 Olds, 55 T-Bird and 69 Firebird - all in mint condition. Wow

The talk and question and answer took a bit too long so we could not continue to Tazewell and the picturesque Court House, hopefully we can see this on a later tour.
